If you have thoughts or observations not related to the prompts below, please feel free to also incorporate those observations into your reflection.

- 1. Describe your interaction with your chosen target population. With whom did you meet? Where did you meet them? Use examples to illustrate your observations.
- 2. What did you learn about how your target population that you did not know before? What did you learn about the target population's place in society? What did you learn about their interactions with government and the broader political system?
- 3. Identify at least one specific concept (you may discuss more than one) from the Schneider & Ingram article that you are able to connect to your experience interacting with your target population. In particular, did your experience confirm or contradict what you would have expected beforehand? How did your interaction affect the argument you are making in your research paper?
